

OFFICIAL IAABO RULES TEST—2004—WRITTEN EXAMINATION

(All questions are based on National Federation Rules)

This examination will be given on Monday, November 1, 2004. This examination is presented in a “Yes-No” format. Carefully read each situation described. If the answer is “YES,” draw a circle around the “Y”. If the answer is “NO”, draw a circle around the “N”. The rulebook may not be used during the examination. In order to pass, the examinee must correctly answer a minimum of 43 questions. Having passed this examination, the candidate is eligible for the floor examination.

NOTE: “In the act of shooting” on this examination means the ball is still in the hands of the shooter. “Tap,” for this examination only, is defined as “the same as a try.”

| 1. Jumper A-1 taps the ball which is touched simultaneously by A-2 and B-2 and goes out of bounds. Official instructs the original jumpers to resume play with a jump ball. Is the official correct? | 1. | Yes | No |
| 2. A-1’s throw-in is tapped into the backcourt by A-2, who is in the frontcourt. A-1 is the first to touch the ball in the backcourt. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? | 2. | Yes | No |
| 3. Airborne player A-1 intercepts a pass near the side line. A-1 seeing he/she will land out of bounds, orally requests a time-out. Official grants the request. Is the official correct? | 3. | Yes | No |
| 4. Thrower-in A-1 holds the ball through the plane of the boundary line. B-1 slaps the ball from A-1’s hands. Official charges B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? | 4. | Yes | No |
| 5. A-1 commits his/her fifth foul and is disqualified. Prior to team A replacing A-1, team A requests a time-out. Official denies the request. Is the official correct? | 5. | Yes | No |
| 6. Prior to the start of the game, team B is charged with a technical foul. A-6 replaces A-1 the designated starter to attempt the free throws. Official allows A-6 to enter the game. Is the official correct? | 6. | Yes | No |
| 7. Player A-1 is fouled while in the act of shooting and injured on the play. The try is unsuccessful. A-6 replaces A-1. Following the successful free throws, A-7 enters to replace A-6. Official allows the substitution. Is the official correct? | 7. | Yes | No |
| 8. A-1’s throw-in is batted by B-1 right back to A-1, who touches the ball while still out of bounds. Official rules A-1 caused the ball to be out of bounds and awards the ball to team B. Is the official correct? | 8. | Yes | No |
| 9. B-1 intentionally extends his/her leg to block the pass. Ball hits A-1 in the inner thigh. Official rules this a kicking violation. Is the official correct? | 9. | Yes | No |
| 10. Airborne shooter A-1 commits a player control foul. Ball lodges between the ring and backboard. Possession arrow favors team A. Official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? | 10. | Yes | No |
| 11. With 3 tenths of a second on the game clock and play is to resume with a throw-in, A-1’s throw-in is caught by A-2, who tries for goal. While the ball is in flight, time expires. Ball enters the basket. Official counts the basket. Is the official correct? | 11. | Yes | No |
| 12. Before A-1’s free throw is released, B-1 enters the lane followed by A-2. The try is unsuccessful. Official awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? | 12. | Yes | No |
| 13. On a try by A-1, the ball is bouncing directly above the ring when B-1 touches the net. Official rules this basket interference. Is the official correct? | 13. | Yes | No |
| 14. A-1’s try is in flight when A-2 fouls B-2. Ball enters basket. Team B is not in the bonus. Official rules team B may run the end line. Is the official correct? | 14. | Yes | No |
| 15. While A-1 is dribbling, B-1 bats the ball away from A-1. A-1 recovers the ball and dribbles. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? | 15. | Yes | No |
| 16. A-1 is erroneously awarded a one and one. A-1 makes the first and misses the second free throw, which is rebounded by B-1, who passes to B-2, who scores. The error is now recognized before the ball is at the disposal of team A. Official cancels the free throw, counts B-2’s basket and resumes play from the point of interruption. Is the official correct? | 16. | Yes | No |
| 17. A-1 is charged with a technical foul in the first quarter. In the fourth quarter A-1 commits his/her fourth personal foul. Official disqualifies A-1. Is the official correct? | 17. | Yes | No |
| 18. A-6 and A-7 leave the confines of the team bench as it appears a fight is imminent. Official charges both with flagrant technical fouls. Is the official correct? | 18. | Yes | No |
| 19. Prior to A-1 attempting his/her first free throw of two, A-6 reports to the scorer’s table to substitute for A-2. The scorer sounds the horn and the official beckons A-6 into the game. Is the official correct? | 19. | Yes | No |
| 20. A-1 has the ball out of bounds for an alternating possession throw-in when B-2 fouls A-2 prior to the bonus. Official awards the ball back to team A and instructs the scorer to turn the arrow when the ball is touched inbounds. Is the official correct? | 20. | Yes | No |
| 21. Prior to releasing the ball in starting his/her dribble, A-1 lifts his/her pivot foot off the floor. Official rules this a traveling violation. Is the official correct? | 21. | Yes | No |
| 22. B-1 is fouled by A-1 and is awarded a one and one. As the official is reporting the foul, B-1 is charged with a technical foul. After all the free throws are completed, official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? | 22. | Yes | No |

23. Yes No 23. A-1, closely guarded in the frontcourt, dribbles the ball for four seconds then holds the ball. Official starts a new count. Is the official correct?
24. Yes No 24. While the ball is in flight on a field goal try, time expires in the third quarter. Before the try ends, A-2 is assessed a technical foul. Official starts the fourth quarter with team B shooting the technical foul. Is the official correct?
25. Yes No 25. During a throw-in by A-1, B-1 breaks the plane of the boundary line. Official issues a warning to team B. Is the official correct?
26. Yes No 26. A-1's throw-in goes directly out of bounds without touching a player inbounds. Official rules this a throw-in violation. Is the official correct?
27. Yes No 27. A-2 fouls B-2 while A-1 is in the act of shooting. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Official cancels the goal. Is the official correct?
28. Yes No 28. Airborne shooter A-1 fouls B-1. Ball enters the basket. Official rules this a player control foul and disallows the basket. Is the official correct?
29. Yes No 29. As A-1 is attempting to retrieve the ball during his/her interrupted dribble, A-1 fouls B-1. Official rules this a player control foul. Is the official correct?
30. Yes No 30. While the ball is dead, A-1 and B-1 foul each other at approximately the same time. Official rules this a double personal foul. Is the official correct?
31. Yes No 31. A-1 is fouled while tapping a rebound toward his/her basket. Ball enters basket. Official rules a tap is treated the same as a try, counts the basket and awards A-1 one free throw. Is the official correct?
32. Yes No 32. While the ball is in flight on a free throw by A-1, A-4 breaks the plane of the three point line before the ball hits the ring, backboard or the free throw ends. Official rules this a free throw violation. Is the official correct?
33. Yes No 33. On A-1's free throw, B-1 and B-2 occupy the first marked lane spaces. Team A chooses not to occupy the second marked lane spaces. B-3 and B-4 occupy the vacant spaces. The official rules that this is legal. Is the official correct?
34. Yes No 34. During an alternating possession procedure throw-in, team A commits a throw-in violation. Official awards team B the ball and has the scorer turn the arrow toward team B's basket. Is the official correct?
35. Yes No 35. Team A has been charged with two technical fouls and four personal fouls when A-1, who does not have the ball, fouls B-1. Official awards B-1 a one and one. Is the official correct?
36. Yes No 36. The scorer notifies the official of a discrepancy in the score. The referee cannot find the error. The referee rules that the progressive score in the official scorebook will prevail. Is the official correct?
37. Yes No 37. A-1 from the backcourt throws the ball toward the frontcourt. B-1, in the frontcourt, bats the ball into the backcourt. A-1 catches the ball and the official starts a new 10 second count. Is the official correct?
38. Yes No 38. While A-1's try is in flight, team control still continues for team A. Is this correct?
39. Yes No 39. A-1 receives the ball while airborne. A-1 lands on the left foot, jumps off that foot and lands simultaneously on both feet. Official rules this a traveling violation. Is the official correct?
40. Yes No 40. During a designated spot throw-in, thrower-in A-1 moves directly backward 4 feet to avoid the defensive pressure. Official rules this a violation for leaving the designated spot. Is the official correct?
41. Yes No 41. A-1, while airborne, passes to A-2. Prior to A-1 returning to the floor, A-1 charges B-1. Official rules this a player control foul. Is the official correct?
42. Yes No 42. Fifteen seconds prior to the expiration of a time-out, the timer sounds a warning horn. Following the warning horn, A-6 reports to the scorer to enter the game. Official denies A-6's entry. Is the official correct?
43. Yes No 43. After A-1's try has passed through the net and before the ball is at the disposal of team B, A-2 shoves B-2. Official rules this a personal foul. Is the official correct?
44. Yes No 44. A-1 is assessed a technical foul. Official awards team B two free throws and awards team B the ball out of bounds nearest the spot of the foul. Is the official correct?
45. Yes No 45. While A-1 is holding the ball and attempting to make a pass to A-2, B-1 purposely obstructs the vision of A-1 by waving or placing his/her hands near A-1's eyes. Official assesses B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct?
46. Yes No 46. A-1 is bleeding and directed to the bench. Team A takes a time-out. Following the time-out, A-1 is ready to play. Official allows A-1 to stay in the game. Is the official correct?
47. Yes No 47. A-1 ends his/her dribble and passes to A-2. A-2 is not able to catch the ball. A-2 bats the ball back in the direction of A-1. A-1 catches the ball and starts another dribble. Official rules this is legal. Is the official correct?
48. Yes No 48. As the ball comes through the net following A-1's try, A-2 gives the ball a tap preventing team B from readily making a throw-in. Official issues a warning for delay of game. Is the official correct?
49. Yes No 49. B-1 commits his/her fifth foul and A-1 is awarded two free throws. Prior to B-1's substitute reporting, A-6 and A-7 report to enter the game. Official beckons both substitutes into the game. Is the official correct?
50. Yes No 50. A-1 is selected to attempt the free throws for a technical foul. After A-1 misses the first attempt, the coach requests A-2 to attempt the second free throw. Official rules the same player must attempt both free throws. Is the official correct?
